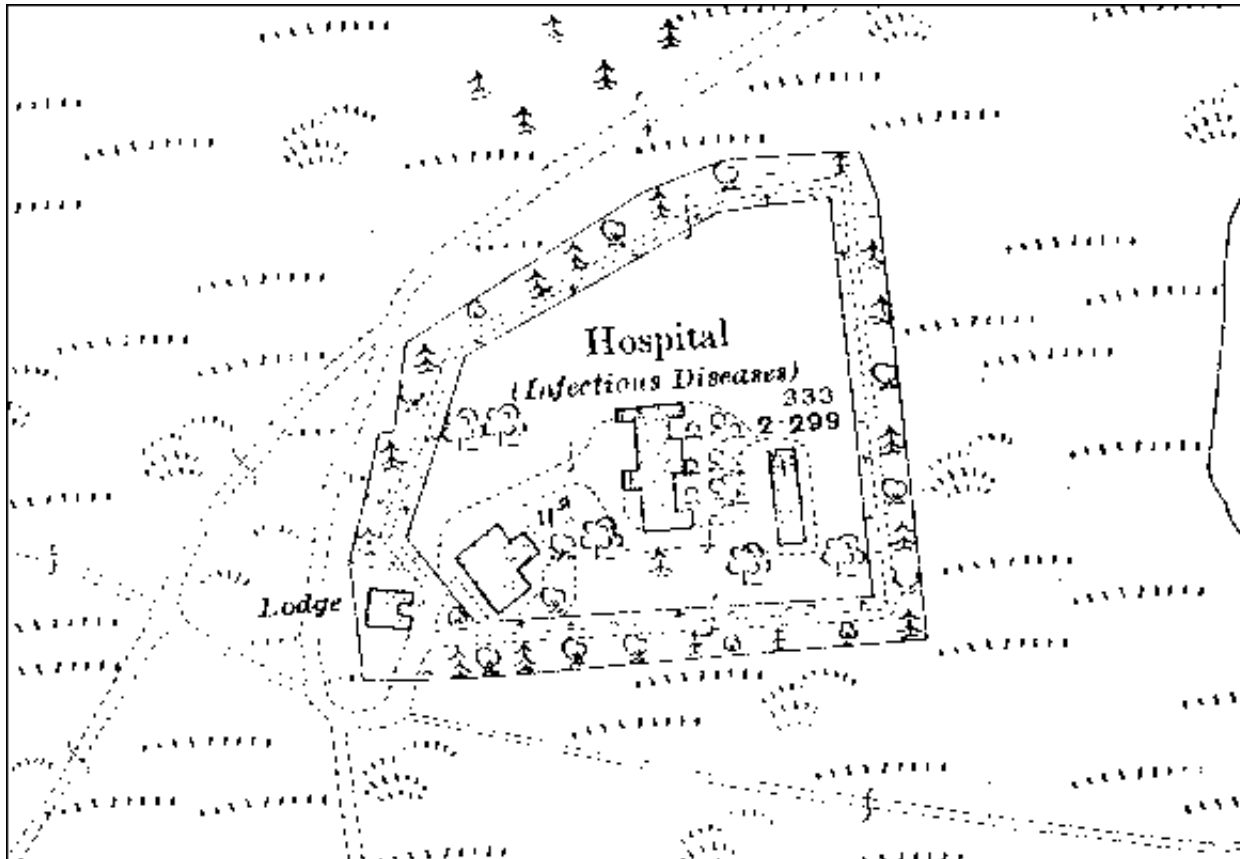


Whitmoor Hospital

In 1900 the Guildford & Godalming Joint Hospitals Board established a smallpox hospital on Whitmoor Common known as Whitmoor Hospital.

It was called upon only intermittently to receive patients and, after standing vacant for some 20 years, it was closed in 1936 and its responsibilities were taken over by the smallpox hospital at East Clandon.
