Borough Councillor's Report – 12 December 2019 For Worplesdon Parish Council

1. Bushy, Backside Common - An enforcement notice has been issued for the change to a commercial swimming pool at Bushy, Backside Common, Wood Street Village. Compliance is due by the 9th March 2020.

2. The 'Weyside Urban Village' - project formerly known as SARP has received the required grants from the Housing Infrastructure Fund and the M3 LEP. So now this project will proceed with the North Moors Allotment Project being the first part of the scheme.

At the GBC presentation on the project I asked if the Clay Lane Link Road (CLLR) was part of the project to be told that the CLLR had been dropped.

3. 1 Fairlands Ave - I have received many complaints about the building site at 1 Fairlands Avenue. I have raised this matter with GBC Planning department who advised me that the method of construction is not covered by the planning approval. However, I raised concerns about building materials blocking access to the electrical sub-station that is alongside the property. The planning enforcement department is investigating this matter.

4. Charter Against Modern Slavery - At the last full meeting of the Borough Council a motion to sign a Charter Against Modern Slavery was approved.
