9. Planning Applications for consideration:

Planning Application No: 20/P/01435 - Tangley Place Farmhouse, Tangley Place Farm, Tangley Lane, Guildford, GU3 3JZ - Changes to fenestration including timber cladding on the elevations and changes to windows. Roof cladding in grey steel with the addition of solar panels.

Planning Application No: 20/P/01512 - Willowmead, Goose Rye Road, Worplesdon, Guildford, GU3 3RJ Replacement dwelling following demolition of existing dwelling and outbuildings.

Planning Application No: <u>20/P/01620</u> - Willow Cottage, 83 Wood Street Green, Wood Street Village, Guildford, GU3 3DY — Replacement attached two bay car barn (retrospective application).

Planning Application No: <u>20/T/00290</u> - The Old Paddock, Perry Hill, Worplesdon, Guildford, GU3 3RE - G1 Lawson Cypress - fell approximately 20 trees (Worplesdon Conservation Area).

Planning Application No: 20/P/01644 - 48 Frog Grove Lane, Wood Street Village, Guildford, GU3 3HA - Replacement of existing felted flat roof with stainless steel standing seam roof.

Planning Application No: 20/P/01648 - 15 Stringers Avenue, Jacobs Well, Guildford, GU4 7NW - Proposed side and rear dormers.

- **11.** Precept 2021/2022 To receive and consider the 1st draft precept for 2021/2022.
- **12. FPPPG Mental Health Event** postponed due to Covid-19. To consider the FPPPG's request to hold over the grant to 2021/2022 to enable this event to take place at a later date.
- 13. Jacobs Well Recreation Ground Ground works: The following safety works are required:
 - Clear to ground level the brambles and saplings alongside The Brook (Dollies pond)
 - Remove all fallen trees in Dollies pond and those that look likely to fall
 - Remove any fallen trees from the perimeter of the pond and make safe any others

- Clear back scrub both sides of the path (to the play area) and reduce the trees overhanging the path
- Select oak trees to grow on and remove the rest that encroach onto the pond and path
- Cut back the blackthorn by the play area
- Cut back scrub encroaching on to the recreational field from White House pond
- Cut back scrub around dead willow tree
- Remove branches from the dead willow tree; leaving a monolith trunk for habitat purposes
- Cut long grass on the outside of the play area
- Remove scrub from the front of Dollies pond and hazels up to the small poplar tree
- Wood chips and timber to be removed
- Alternatively, to leave timber (banded) and wood chips on site; reduce price quoted by £1,000 &
 VAT

Total cost £8,110 & VAT or £7,110 & VAT if timber and wood chips left on site.

The Council should consider the need for undertaking any ecological surveys prior to the works commencing.

- **14. Quarterly playground inspections** To receive the quarterly playground inspections. All items highlighted within the reports are low risk
- 15. Armistice Day Private Event Worplesdon Parish Council only 11 November 2020 at 11am Due to Covid-19, this year's event will be a simple, private event at which wreaths will simultaneously be laid by Worplesdon Parish Council at the war memorial in Queenhythe Road and in Harry's Meadow beside the WW1 commemorative bench.
- 16. Purchase of one new Speed Data Recorder (SDR) and one new temporary Vehicle Activate sign (VAS) The existing equipment has reached the end of its life expectancy and will require regular repairs if not replaced. Additionally, our equipment is not compatible with the Surrey Safer Camera Partnership's equipment. Their Speed Survey Technician is now assisting Worplesdon Parish Council with its speed data monitoring. To approve the cost of one new SDR Cost £2,790 & VAT and one new VAS sign plus additional brackets Cost £2,298 & VAT.
- 17. Harry's Meadow Without prejudice and subject to contract A request has been received enquiring whether Worplesdon Parish Council would grant a minimum 20-year lease (with no landlord break) for permission to install a Data Centre facility (compound to measure 7.5m x 7.5m) to facilitate the delivery of a new, full fibre, network to the borough. Anticipated income between £3K £5K per annum. A separate wayleave would be required to run a fibre duct from the adopted highway into Harry's Meadow. To consider the request.

- a) Repainting work Worplesdon Play Area: 2 x steel benches, basketball post and centre section of the Typhoon to be repainted as soon as practicable by Dick Randall Services Ltd Total cost £698 & VAT. Quotation accepted under delegated authority.
- **b)** <u>Surrey County Council Surrey Community Projects Fund:</u> Co-Design £20m of funding available each year for 5 years towards community projects.
