
There will be some noise, but we will try to keep this to a minimum.



What are we doing?

• We will be applying surface dressing to the road. For more information visit: www.ourroads.today.

What is surface dressing?

- Surface dressing involves spreading a thin layer of glue-like material called bitumen on the road and then spreading chippings over the entire surface from kerb to kerb. Traffic on the road will embed the chippings into the bitumen to form the new surface.
- The main work should take a maximum of 1 to 2 days. We allow 4 days for the works to cover programme changes and we return to sweep away loose chippings three times - usually 24 hours, 48 hours and then again seven days after the initial works.



Extent of works:

Information for residents and businesses

Goose Rye Road will be closed from The Avenue to the A322 Rickford while we carry out these works. We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business but there will be times when delays are unavoidable. Talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

- For a few days after the work and during prolonged spells of hot weather, the surface may still be sticky and could easily be carried into your home on shoes – make sure you take your shoes off to avoid marking your floor.
- This type of work is weather dependent and bad weather means the work will be rescheduled.
- Due to the fast-moving nature of this type of work, dates can vary. If we're
 unable to work on the date on this leaflet, please make sure the road is left
 clear of vehicles the following working day.
- Please keep the road free from parked vehicles. Park elsewhere on the day we're working otherwise it may be towed to a nearby road. You can park on the road once the surface dressing is completed and you don't have to park elsewhere when we sweep the loose chippings.
- Sign up here <u>one.network</u> to receive an alert with any changes to dates, access information, delays and when works have been completed.
- Road markings will not be replaced until after the final sweep has taken place. It can take a few weeks for the lines to be replaced.
