Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 09 May 2023]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. <u>This Order is</u> made by Guildford Borough Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (Ref. 20/P/00197) namely: Change of use of amenity land to deliver 78 allotment plots, bee keeping facilities, composting areas, community buildings, landscaping and associated cycle storage and car parking. —

BY THIS ORDER:-

- 1 <u>THE footpath</u> over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule of this Order ("the schedule") shall be diverted.
- <u>There shall be</u> created to the reasonable satisfaction of Surrey County Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. <u>The diversion</u> of the footpath shall have effect on the confirmation of this Order by the Guildford Borough Council AND for avoidance of doubt the confirmation shall not occur until Surrey County Council certifies its reasonable satisfaction with the alternative highway for use as replacement for the said footpath ______

- Guildford Borough Council is hereby required to pay the cost of all works required including:-
 - Signposting and waymarking, to bring the proposed diversion into use;
 - Providing a surfaced path with a minimum width of 2.0 metres to the satisfaction of Surrey County Council;
 - The costs incurred in making the Order.
- 6. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE PART 1

Description of site of existing path or way

Footpath from point A 182 metres south south east of Jacobs Well Village Hall and Club at the north west corner of the proposed allotment site (Grid Ref. 500113 152813) in a generally south easterly direction for 237 metres to Point B (Grid Ref. 500285 152682), as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/74/H18A

Description of site of alternative highway

Footpath from point A 182 metres south south east of Jacobs Well Village Hall and Club at the north west corner of the proposed allotment site (Grid Ref. 500113 152813) in a south south easterly direction for 160 metres to Point C (Grid Ref. 500176 15266) then in an easterly direction for 110 metres to Point D (Grid Ref. 500287 152665), as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/74/H18A. The Footpath to have a width of 2 metres throughout and to be known as Public Footpath 581 (Worplesdon).


