Whilst there have over those years been some examples of vandalism / damage to the grass on the green by an occasional car driven over it in the winter period, the damage is usually self healing - come spring. The suggestion of posts around the full perimeter of the green would be visually intrusive changing its visual character and extreemly expensive to install. If timber - there will certainly be a long term maintenance commitment. I am therefore totally opposed to any change. It is my belief if a driver is intent upon damaging the Green - a barrier will see it as a challenge to still get on.
