Deploying the Speed Data Recorder in the Parish of Worplesdon

The objectives for deploying the SDR in all four villages across the Parish are:

- 1. To ascertain the number, and speed, of vehicles using the road network within the Parish.
- 2. To build up a picture of the level of traffic in the four villages, particularly the extent of peak time traffic on the local road network.
- 3. To provide statistical evidence on traffic numbers for the Local Plan Examination in Public response to development and public concern.
- 4. To investigate residents' concerns about speeding traffic e.g. in Frog Grove Lane, Oak Hill, Broad Street, Clay Lane, Jacobs Well Road etc.
- 5. If a speeding issue is proven; pass that information onto Surrey County Council and Surrey Police in order that action can be taken to remedy the problem.
- 6. Lobby the County Council and Surrey Police to ensure appropriate action is taken. Data to be made available to Councillors.

The County Council and Surrey Police will not accept traffic surveys undertaken during school holidays. Bank holidays should also be avoided.

Sites for deployment:

Jacobs Well:

- Salt Box Road (Near the Whitmoor Common car park).
- Salt Box Road (between the Mount Pleasant and Grange Road).
- Clay Lane (near Queenhythe Road).
- Clay Lane (between Burpham Court Farm and Safeguard Coaches).
- Jacobs Well Road (near the village hall and the junction of Queenhythe Road).
- Woking Road (between Salt Box Road and Jacobs Well Road).

Fairlands:

- At the entrance to the Estate
- Aldershot Road (near the entrance to Hunts Farm and by Clasford Farm)
- Aldershot Road (near the Cricketers)

Wood Street Village:

- Frog Grove Lane
- Oak Hill
- Broad Street
- Park Barn Drive

Perry Hill/Worplesdon

- Holly Lane
- Worplesdon Road Near Tangley Lane
- Worplesdon Road St Mary's Church
- Worplesdon Road Rickford
- Goose Rye Road

And any other suitable locations as required to address residents' concerns.
