A 10ft wide strip of vegetation will be left beside Nightingale Old Farm for the benefit of local wildlife.

White Hart Lane – Section to the narrow bridge grass cut 4 times per season. The next section to be left in a "natural" state albeit the brambles will be flailed back from the road edge when necessary. Ditch to be de-silted every other year.

The ditch near Nightingale Old Farm to be de-silted as and when required.

Pond to be de-silted as and when required. Bulrushes and other weeds to be removed as and when required.

Maypole – To be inspected monthly. Electricity supply to be checked by a competent electrician annually prior to the WSVA Summer Show (WSVA to ensure checks carried out and provide WPC with evidence). Repairs to be carried out as and when required. Maypole to be replaced as and when required. Benches – To be inspected monthly. Repairs to be carried out as and when required. Replacement at the discretion of WPC.

General Notes

Residents must not arrange for tree surgery to be undertaken without the prior knowledge and written permission from WPC. This will only be permitted in exceptional circumstances.

Planting – Planting may only take place with the express permission of WPC. Non-native plants will not be permitted under any circumstances.

Replacement Trees - Trees will be planted and/or replaced at the sole discretion of the Parish Council.
