A Brief Guide to Public Participation – **First fifteen minutes of the meeting only**

This meeting commences at 7.30pm. The public participation session is held towards the start of the meeting. A public participation session of no more than fifteen minutes will be provided. Each speaker to have a maximum of three minutes to address the Council. The number of speakers to be limited to five. Where a number of people wish to make similar representations, they should be prepared to select one person from amongst their number to speak for them all.

Speakers will be invited to the front of the room to address the Council. Once the final speaker has finished and retaken their seat, the public will no longer be permitted to speak or to ask questions. If a member of the public interrupts the proceedings, the Chairman may, after due warning, order that they be removed from the meeting.
