	<p><b>Notes</b></p> <p>Any resident wishing to cut grass outside their property boundary must obtain a licence from the Parish Council.</p> <p>Residents are not permitted to use weed killer on the common land outside of their boundary fences.</p> <p>Residents must not arrange for tree surgery to be undertaken without the prior knowledge and written permission of the Parish Council.</p> <p>The current owner of The Ridings has been granted verbal permission to cut the grass on this side of the lane.</p> <p><b>Common Land</b> June – cut back a 2m strip to clear the edge of the road. October cut the entire verge.</p>

Christmas tree lights are to be checked mid-November by a qualified electrician. Lights to be turned on by 1 December annually. Lights to be removed and replaced every 3 years to accommodate tree growth, next replacement December 2028.

	<p><b>Notes</b></p> <p><b>Invasive weeds</b> - All ragwort to be pulled up and burnt in accordance with the Weeds Act 1959 and Ragwort Control Act 2003.</p> <p><b>Perimeter of the Green</b> to be strimmed back annually in October/November to distance of 12 feet from the wall to prevent encroachment of brambles and saplings onto the Green. Remaining strip of land to be left wild for biodiversity purposes.</p>

Technically the Parish Council should issue a licence to any residents wishing to place posts or marker stones on the common land outside their properties, however, many of these barriers have been in-situ for a significant number of years. Any encroachment issues to be dealt with by Surrey County Council. Posts near Billhurst Farm were placed by the Parish Council, These posts only to be replaced by the Parish Council as and when required. 	<p><b>Notes</b></p> <p>A 10ft wide strip of vegetation will be left beside Nightingale Old Farm for the benefit of local wildlife.</p> <p><b>White Hart Lane</b> – Section to the narrow bridge grass cut 4 times per season. The next section to be left in a “natural” state albeit the brambles will be flailed back from the road edge when necessary. Ditch to be de-silted every other year.</p> <p>The ditch near Nightingale Old Farm to be de-silted as and when required.</p> <p><b>Pond</b> to be de-silted as and when required. Bulrushes and other weeds to be removed as and when required. De-silting planned for 2026/2027.</p> <p><b>Maypole</b> – To be inspected monthly. Electricity supply to be checked by a competent electrician annually prior to the WSV A Summer Show (WSVA to ensure checks carried out and provide WPC with evidence). Repairs to be carried out as and when required. Maypole to be replaced as and when required.</p> <p><b>Benches</b> – To be inspected monthly. Repairs to be carried out as and when required. Replacement at the discretion of WPC.</p>						

## General Notes

Residents must not arrange for tree surgery to be undertaken without the prior knowledge and written permission from WPC. This will only be permitted in exceptional circumstances.

**Planting** – Planting may only take place with the express permission of WPC. Non-native plants will not be permitted under any circumstances.

**Replacement Trees** - Trees will be planted and/or replaced at the sole discretion of the Parish Council.
