

Land Management Nevins Copse

– May 2026 onwards

- 1) No pesticides to be used onsite.
- 2) Tree inspections to be carried out every 12 to 18 months by specialist contractor.
- 3) Once a year (Autumn) brush cutting of seedling tree (usually Sycamore and Ash) from cleared openings.
- 4) All felled trees to be left on site for biodiversity purposes (habitat piles).
- 5) Coppice Hazel and Ash where practicable. All arisings to piled up and left on site.
- 6) Continue cutting and clearing as required.
- 7) Continue stump removal as required.
- 8) Maintain designated paths around Copse, edged with cut and pegged tree stems.
- 9) Continue removal of Laurel where required.
