Worplesdon Parish Council is reviewing its Strategic Business Plan, which sets out our priorities and objectives for the years ahead.

The Local Government Review currently underway will see the abolition of Surrey County Council and the 11 District and Borough Councils on 31 March 2027. It is likely that services will be devolved to Worplesdon Parish Council, for example, the transfer of the North Moors Allotments and three play facilities (Broadacres, Baird Drive, and Roman Farm Road) from Guildford Borough Council.

The Parish Council is committed to making decisions based on evidence and community engagement. Your responses to this survey will help inform our future priorities, projects and investment over the coming years, particularly given these pending changes.

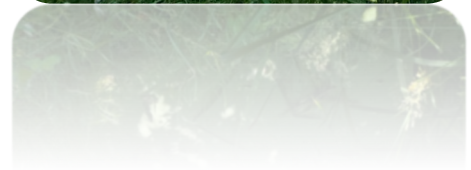
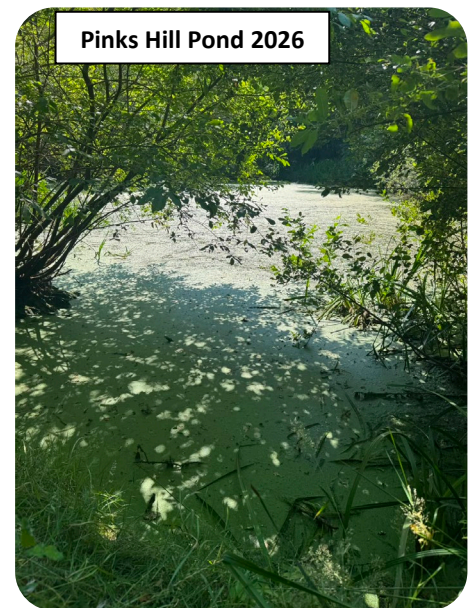
